SMALL GOURDS




Autumn Wings: A warty gourd mix with vibrant colors from creams and yellows to whites and greens. 6-8" long


Daisy Gourd: A colorful mix of green, orange, yellow, and white, all with a unique daisy pattern on the end. 3" x 2" long


Large Bottle: 12 to 15" long, this smooth gourd is used for fall décor, and to make birdhouses and painted crafts.
